Beginning with the earliest Stone Age settlements, she combines new translations of early Gaelic and medieval Latin prayers with original research to chart: * the founding of the abbey in 563AD * six centuries of monasticism: food, lifestyle, work and the pattern of daily prayer * architecture, the high crosses and early art * medieval Iona: the nunnery, women's lives, and catering for pilgrims * post Reformation Iona: the rebuilding of the Abbey, the lives of the resident population and what visitors from the 17th century onwards experienced.
