The stencilled Inserts issued with the Guide to bring its information up to the date of sale are also twice their former size, to permit of giving plans of the ground floor as well as the main floor. The plans contain the names of the galleries and offices as listed in the printed pages. The Inserts aim to record all important changes of exhibition since the Guide was printed and to give other current information as space permits. The purpose of the Guide is to make available to the visitor at a nominal cost a complete outline of all that the Museum offers from day to day. It is planned to meet the needs at once of those visitors who come at long intervals for a tour of the building and of those who come more often with special interests. MRS. HENRI LEON BERGER (Miss Florence V. Paul), long Assistant in Charge of the Collections of Western Art at the Museum (excepting the Collection of Textiles), has been appointed General Curator of the Wadsworth Athenaeum, Hartford, Connecticut. The Wadsworth Athenaeum was erected in 1842 to house the Public Library of Hartford (then the Young Men's Institute) and the Connecticut Historical Society, as well as a collection of objects of art.
