It is further clear that we cannot interpret all structural peculiarities which result from injury as reversions to a former condition of organization, but only those which are definitely paralleled by known conditions in fossil forms or are illustrated in the anatomy of the conservative organs--the leaf, reproductive axis, and stem, or at least some of these. Carefully as the doctrines of recapitulation and of conservative parts must be applied to elucidate the course of evolution, the principle of reversion must be invoked in phylogenetic studies with even greater precautions.
