Since it was launched in 1929, the comic series The Adventures of Tintin by pioneering Belgian cartoonist Hergé has influenced generations of cartoonists, as well as artists like Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein, and has earned awards as lofty as the International Campaign for Tibet's Light of Truth Award while entertaining millions of children and adults in 38 languages.
